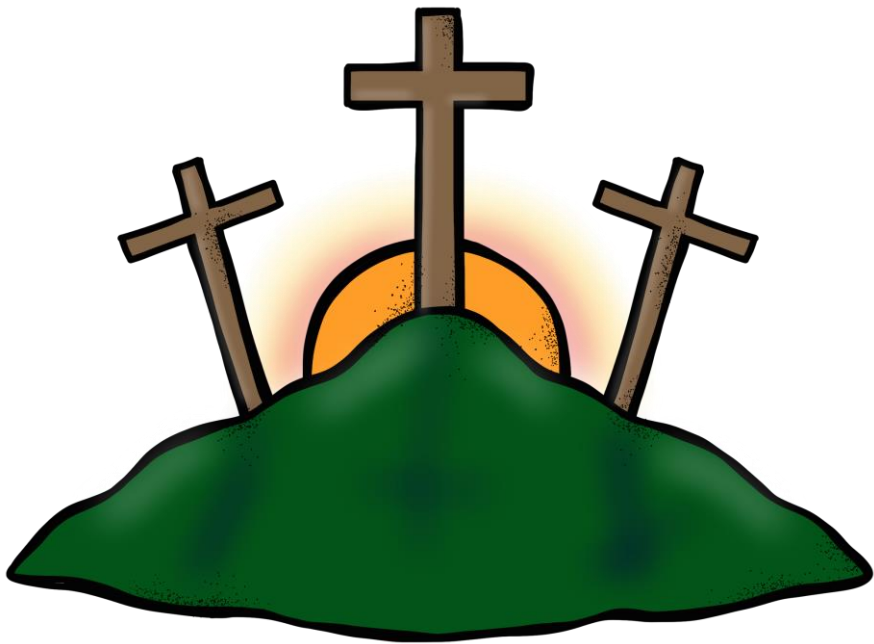


# Easter Story

# The Tomb Is Empty

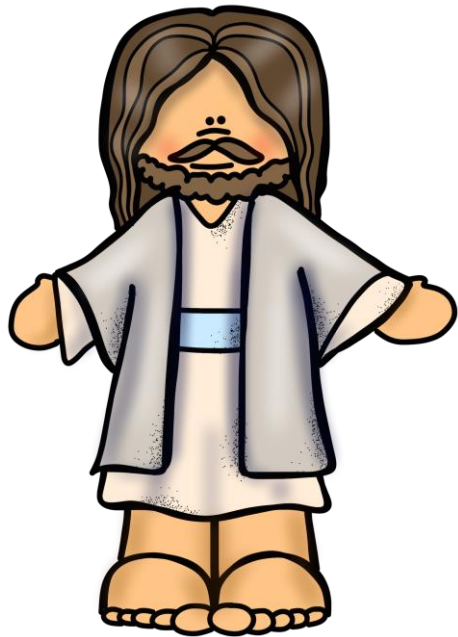
Early on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb. It was still dark.
